Walk-in Office Hours

We are available to help residents solve problems, find needed resources and information, and to provide translation and interpretation when possible.

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Summer Camp

Crafts, games, ESL instruction, field days and educational field trips for school-aged children. Separate evening program for teens with weekly educational field trips.

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Elementary After School Programs

Providing homework help, English-language instruction, and recreational activities for refugee children with tutors and mentors present.

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Girl Scouts

Tuesdays during the school year at 4:30 pm for teen girls and at 5:30 for elementary-school girls.

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Teen After-School Program

After-school recreation, one-on-one tutoring, projects, discussions, and field trips for refugee teens. Also includes the Refugee Adolescent Advocacy Program.

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Food and Clothing Pantry

Food supplies available monthly and fresh produce offered every Friday.
